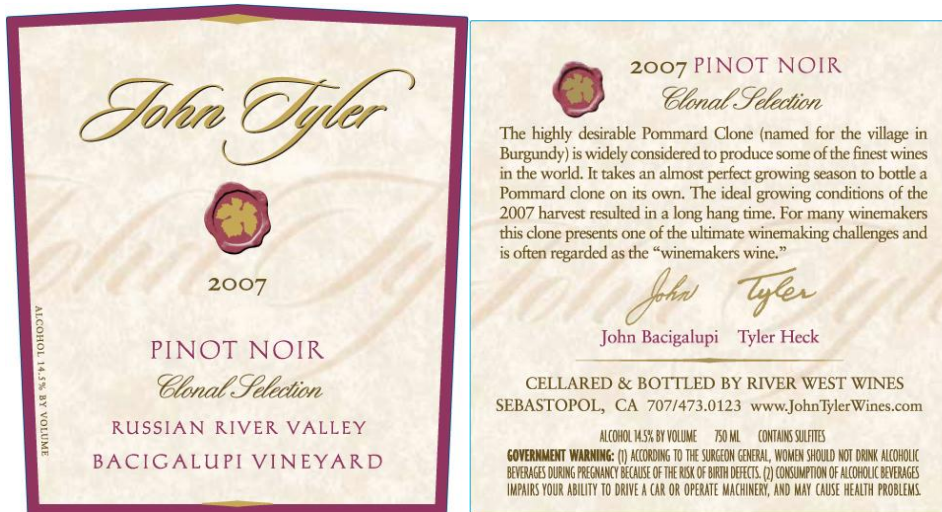

**2007 Pinot Noir Clonal Selection  
Bacigalupi Vineyards  
Russian River Valley**



**Tasting Notes:** *The highly desirable Pommard Clone (named for the village in Burgundy) is widely considered to produce some of the finest wines in the world. It is a difficult clone to cultivate due to its sensitivity to light, cropping levels, soil types and pruning techniques. It takes an almost perfect growing season to bottle a Pommard clone on its own. 2007 saw ideal growing conditions in the vineyard resulting in a long hang time. For many winemakers this clone presents one of the ultimate winemaking challenges and is often regarded as the "winemakers wine." This wine is 100% Pommard Clone.*

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**Vineyard Location:** *Bacigalupi Vineyards– Russian River Valley Appellation  
Climate: cool mornings and warm afternoon  
Soil: Rocky volcanic and sandy loam*

**Cooperage:** *Barreled down in 100% new French oak cooperage a mix of Francois Freres and Berthomieu*

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**Production Notes:** *At all times and in every aspect the winemaking process was under the direction of Tyler Heck. All the decisions and work pertaining to the production of this vintage were made by him.*
